

Schumaker's Sure-Fire Strategy for Successfully Solving Some (Stressful) Statement Problems



- 1. Identify/record the unknown(s).
- 2. Assign a variable to each unknown*.
- 3. Identify/record the knowns (given info) using phrases, pictures, diagrams, tables, etc.
- 4. Determine/write a *system of linear equations* representing the relationships between the unknown & known quantities. The number of equations needed will be the same as the number of variables used (refer to step 2).
- 5. Solve the system of equations, then use the solutions as needed to answer the original problem (refer back to step 1).
- *Usually requires a unique variable for each unknown quantity.
