Student Scholarship Application for 2017-18

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarship assistance to outstanding students pursuing a degree or certificate in Culinary Arts at Hawai'i Community College. Funds shall be used for costs associated with attendance (e.g. tuition, books, fees, etc.).

Award: \$1,000

Eligibility:

Recipients must be enrolled at least part-time as an undergraduate student pursuing a degree in Culinary Arts at Hawai'i Community College.

Criteria:

1. Must be enrolled full or part-time in the Culinary Arts program at Hawai'i Community College.
2. Academic merit as demonstrated by a minimum GPA of 3.0.
3. Must be a resident of the State of Hawai'i.
4. Some degree of financial need, not necessarily determined by federal guidelines.
5. Preference given to Hawai'i high school graduates.

1. Application form.
2. Short personal statement addressing criteria.
