



Hilo High School Class of 1940 Endowed Scholarship

Student Scholarship Application for 2017-18

Deadline: Friday, September 1, 2017

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships to entering first-year freshman students in any area of study at Hawai'i Community College. Funds shall be used for costs associated with attendance (i.e. tuition, books, fees, etc.).

The Hilo High School Class of 1940 launched a scholarship endowment in 1990 during their 50th class reunion. More than 120 classmates raised more than \$18,000 to establish a fund that would provide Hilo High School graduates with scholarships in perpetuity.

Award Amount: \$1,000

Eligibility:

Recipient must be a full-time, first-year student in any area of study at Hawai'i Community College.

Criteria:

1. Must be a graduate of Hilo High School.
2. Must have financial need as determined by federal guidelines (FAFSA).
3. Demonstrate good moral character.
4. Preference given to a graduating senior from Hilo High School.

Required documents:

1. Application form.
2. Letters of recommendation.
3. Short essay/personal statement addressing criteria.
