Student Scholarship Application for 2017-18

Deadline: Friday, September 1, 2017

The Richard Nip Endowed Scholarship in Accounting will be awarded to students who demonstrate hard work, strong values, overcoming adversity and persevering personally and academically to achieve career goals in Accounting. Funds shall be used to assist the student with any expenses related to cost of attendance (e.g. tuition, fees, books, uniforms, etc.).

Award Amount: \$1,000

Eligibility:

Recipient must be enrolled as a half-time or full-time undergraduate student in Accounting at Hawai'i Community College.

Criteria:

1. Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.
2. Enrolled at least half-time (6 credits minimum).
3. Declared major in Accounting.
4. Must be a resident of the Island of Hawaii.
5. Demonstrated interest in, or service to, the field of accounting.
6. Participation in extracurricular activities, including full or part-time employment and/or service to the community.

Required documents:

1. Application form.
2. One-two page personal statement that addresses the following:
 - a) Personal and career goals in accounting
 - b) Challenges you have faced in your life and how you were able to overcome those challenges
 - c) Service to the community
 - d) Current employment
