1. The <u>College Hour Calendar</u> has been updated with 1) a revised name -Schedule of College Meetings 2018 - 2019; 2) a date correction - Spring break; 3) the addition of *Kauhale* Days; and 4) revised planning notes.

2. Changes to the origninal January 2018 restructure proposal continue with new <u>funtional statements</u> and a <u>revised organization chart</u> dated November 2, 2018. Below is the history so far:

In January, the Chancellor submitted a restructure proposal to UHCC Vice President Morton. Jan. 13, 2018 (original restructure proposal)

Since that time, major changes have occurred which have contributed to additional suggestions for the restructure proposal. Those changes were incorporated into the September 9, 2018 revised restructure proposal and are specifically listed below.
