"Mathematics in Hawai'i"

Hilo, Hawaii July 24-28, 2006

<u>Conference Site</u>: The Big Island of Hawaii, also known as the Orchid Island, will be the site of an AMATYC Summer Institute, "Mathematics in Hawaii." It will be hosted by Hawaii Community College and the Pacific Islands

Mathematical Association of Two-year Colleges π -MATYC on July 24-28, 2006. The Island of Hawaii is home to Kilauea Volcano, the world's most active volcano, and Mauna Kea, the tallest mountain in the world. Twice as large as the other Hawaiian islands combined, the Big Island is often called a mini-continent because it encompasses 4,038 square miles of the most varied topography and lush foliage in the world.

Mathematics in Hawaii: The institute will focus on math application problems from the Island of Hawai`i. Topics will include Astronomy, Geology/Volcanology, Marine Biology/Oceanography and Botany. Field trips are planned to include the Volcano National Park, the Onizuka Center for International Astronomy Visitors' Station, an oceanside park excursion, and a Botany walking tour.

<u>Instructors (tentative):</u> Charles P. McKeague (Mathematics) will be the featured keynote speaker/facilitator; staff members from the University of Hawaii at Hilo's Dept. of Astronomy & Physics, Marine Options Program, and the Center for the Study of Active Volcanoes will deliver each of the specialty presentations, while a staff member of the Hawaii Community College forest Team will conclude the institute's activities.
