### **Advanced Placement Examination Program**

## Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to describe the College's position on advanced placement exams and delineate how a student may apply for this option.

## Background:

The College's practices in this area were reviewed by the Academic Senate in Spring 2002. The Senate's recommendations were submitted on April 9, 2002.

### Policy:

Credit for comparable HawCC courses, as well as advanced standing, may be granted to students who complete Advanced Placement Tests offered by the College Entrance Examination Board.
