





#### **ATI TEAS TRANSCRIPT**

As a reminder, purchase of an official TEAS transcript is necessary if you took the TEAS exam at a different institution than Hawai'i CC. ATI provides one complimentary official transcript when you first register for the TEAS. Official transcripts are purchased in your ATI TEAS account at <a href="https://www.atitesting.com/">https://www.atitesting.com/</a>. Once you have logged into your TEAS account, select the MY RESULTS tab. Then click SEND TRANSCRIPT. The Hawai'i CC institution code is HICC ADN or HICC PN.

## **TRANSCRIPTS**


For the University of Hawai'i (UH) Unofficial STAR Transcripts, upload a pdf copy of your STAR "Combination Transcript by Department" for All Campuses and Degree Levels. Carefully review your STAR Transcript to ensure that ALL prerequisite courses are listed! If applicable, also attach a copy of your official non-UH transcripts have not already been processed by the Admissions and Records Office and/or are not already included in the STAR transcript.
